A total of 565 members attended this convention.

The 11th Japan West Regional Convention was held at Nara, the oldest Capital, on June 14th and 15th. More than 850 people attended. It was also a very productive and impressive convention. Six members: President Suzuki, Past President Fujii, Mr. and Mrs. Futami and Mr and Mrs. TAK had a chance to participate in the



convention. After two nights stay at Nara, we drove down to Shirahama Hot Springs, staying at the Exiv Hotel for two nights, drove around Kumano, Shingu and Mt. Koyasan. Returned home on June 18th at midnight. I was the driver and navigator.
