Takao Nishimura, International Secretary General moves from Geneva to Chang Mai Thailand. This move is to save money on rent.

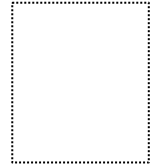

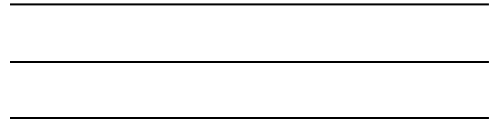
Welcome to the world of Y's Men's International.
