

METRO DISTRICT MEETING

DG PHIL CHUN called the first meeting of the Metro District Council on Wednesday, June 24th, at the Kalihi YMCA. A beef stew dinner was provided by the Kalihi Y's Men with a nominal charge of \$5 per person to some 22 members in attendance representing all six clubs in the District.

Reports from all clubs show a positive direction in membership as Windward, Central, and Kalihi reported membership increase.

Future meetings for the year will be hosted by the Nuuanu Y's Men on October 28th, Central Y's Men on January 27th, and the West Oahu Y's Men on or about March 24th (Annual District Conference). Dinners that will precede the meetings will be provided at a nominal charge, except for the District Conference which is covered by the Metro District.

Other Programs on the Agenda

- A District Christmas Party is being set for Friday, December 4th at the Kalihi YMCA. To provide more time to working members, the program will begin around 7 pm.
- A Camp Project in October (during Make a Difference Day)

- The Endowment Dinner will be a District Program in 2010.

DUKE CHUNG, chair of the 2010 Hawaii Region Convention, voiced some concern with the respect to the willingness of the East Kauai Y's Men to assist in the coordination with the Kauai hotels if the convention is located there.

HAWAIIAN REGION CONVENTION

The 73rd Hawaiian Region Convention was an interesting outing for Y's Men. This year, the room accommodation was at the Ilima Hotel, while the meetings and meals were shared at the Ilima and Miramar Hotels. The schedule of the convention began in earnest around noon on Saturday, and ended with the Sunday night banquet.

The convention program was a bit interesting. RUSS LYNCH of the Windward Y's Men graciously accepted the nomination for Regional Director Elect prior to the convention, but the hosting of the 2010 convention was in question.

MAURICE SHIMONISHI led a discussion that resulted in all clubs deciding that an annual convention was good and should be continued. However, the thought of having a convention on Kauai was up in the air, with the East Kauai Y's Men voting not to "host" on Kauai. It was thought that their concern was the work related with chairing the convention. Under the new organization, Duke Chung was appointed the convention chair, and the Metro District clubs would then provide much of the planning. It was discussed and explained that the only responsibility for the East Kauai club was coordinating with the Hotels on the meals and hotel accommodations. At this point, JOHN SIMPSON, their incoming president, accepted the idea. However, the East Kauai club have not accepted this thought as of this writing.
