

Registration Fee: Y20,000 per person
Y35,000 couples special
Y18,000 early bird registration (by March 31st)

HAWAII REGION CONVENTION COMMITTEE MEETS

Duke Chung held a followup convention committee meeting on Saturday, November 7th at the Kalihi YMCA.

All six clubs in the District were present, and approved the following:

- The convention site will be the Pacific Beach Hotel on May 15th and 16th.
- The convention will begin on Saturday, around 11 am and end with a later afternoon program on Sunday
- Convention Registration Fee will be kept at \$25.00 for delegates
- Room prices will approximate \$123.13 per night (inclusive of taxes), maximum four to a room; the price will be held from Thursday to Tuesday
- The meal package of four meals (Sat Lunch & Dinner, Sun Breakfast and Lunch) will be \$125.00; Individual meal prices are being worked on
- The meals is tentatively set (individual prices are being worked on)
 - Saturday Deli Lunch Buffet, guessed price of \$27.00
 - Saturday Buffet Dinner, guessed price of \$48.00
 - Sunday Breakfast Buffet, guessed price of \$25.00
 - Sunday Grilled Salmon Lunch, guessed price of \$30.00
- Free parking to hotel room guest will be provided, one car per room
- Parking for daily function is \$3 for up to 12 hours
- "Captain's Bar" service will be provided at the dinner, with approximate prices of \$5.25 for beer; \$3.00 for a can of soda; \$33.50 for a bottle of wine (price are tax and tip included)

The next Convention meeting will be held immediately after the Region's Mid Year Cabinet Meeting on November 21st at the Ilima Hotel. A draft of the registration form will be distributed at that time, and if no changes, will be distributed thereafter.
