## **Flight**

Hilo International Airport (ITO) offers flights from Hawaiian Airlines and United Airlines (direct from Los Angeles Intl Airport). The hotel is 2.7 miles (7 min. drive) from the airport.

Kona International Airport (KOA) offers flights from more airlines, however it is located about 77.5 miles (1 hour 45 min. drive) from the hotel. Car rental will be necessary.

## **Ground Transportation**

Airport car rentals are located across street from the baggage claim area and in nearby Hilo town. Make arrangements prior to arriving in Hilo.
